


HERMISTON'S CONSUMER-OWNED ELECTRIC UTILITY

Hermiston Energy Services (HES) is a not-forprofit electric utility, which means rates are set at actual cost. This includes the cost to purchase electricty from BPA and the cost to maintain and upgrade the system. HES operates on a 10-year workplan to ensure reliability by replacing outdated equipment.

HES is in the process of fully updating the system purchased in 2001, including aging copper lines. To meet increasing costs, the utility is requesting a rate adjustment in 2025.



HES By the Numbers

- ► Formed on Oct 1, 2001
- ▶ 4,752 residential customers (51.5% of sales)
- 842 commercial customers (47.9% of sales)
- 0 data center customers
- ► **36.3** miles of overhead lines
- ▶ 19.6 miles of underground lines
- ▶ 108 million kilowatt-hours of annual sales
