## Conditions and Provisions

- 1. Permittee agrees to save, keep and hold harmless the City of Hermiston, its officers, agents and employees from all damages, costs or expenses in law or equity that may at any time arise or be set up because of damage to property, or of personal injury received by reason of or in the course of performing work authorized by this permit which may be occasioned by any act or omission of the permittee, their agents or employees. The City will not be liable for any accident, loss or damage to the work prior to its completion and acceptance.
- 2. Traffic control plan required per MUTCD.
- 3. Compaction testing is required on all trenches in the ROW. See trench backfill spec ST20
- 4. Hard surface replacement MUST be completed by the work end date. If not completed within this time the city may complete the repairs and bill the permittee accordingly. Current fees are \$10.00 per sq ft plus MOB \$300.00.
- 5. IF HARD SURFACE REPLACEMENT CAN'T BE DONE IMMEDIATELY, A COLD PATCH OR STEEL PLATED TRAFFIC PLATES MUST BE INSTALLED TEMPORARILY IN ALL LANES OF TRAFFIC FLOW. THIS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE CONTRACTOR LEAVES THE JOB SITE.
- 6. Permit is void 60 days after date of issue unless otherwise noted. A time extension shall be requested not less than 24 hours prior to expiration.
- 7. Concrete curb, sidewalk, gutters, driveway approaches, paving repairs, etc. shall be constructed per City Standards.
- 8. Oregon law requires the rules to be followed that are set forth by the Oregon Utility Notification Center. Those rules can be found in OAR 952-001-0010 to 0090. Call before you dig- 811 or 800-332-2344 www.callbeforeyoudig.com.
- 9. Permittee shall adequately safeguard all excavations and obstructions with barricades, lights, and/or suitable safety devices. Per MUTCD and OSHA
- 10. Permittee shall be responsible for preserving construction survey stakes and markers for the duration of their usefulness.
- 11. Construction water shall not be taken from a fire hydrant until a fire hydrant meter has been obtained. Please call 541-567-5521 to obtain one.
- 12. A minimum of 24-hour advance notice must be given for inspection requests. (Excludes weekends and holidays).
- 13. Forms and subgrade must be inspected and approved prior to pouring. Failure to obtain approval before proceeding with work may be cause for denial. Any work done on a Saturday, Sunday or holiday must get prior approval.
- 14. Any work done without proper inspections will be subject to rejection. Permittee shall request inspections when: 1) forms are complete/ready for concrete 2) subgrade is compacted and ready for rock, pavement or concrete 3) excavation is started 4) all work authorized by this permit has been completed; and 5) any time assistance is needed to assure compliance with City requirements. Reinspection's will be done at the expense of the permittee IF; the work was not ready for inspection when scheduled or for the replacement of defective work.
- 15. Asphalt pavement, including resurfacing, shall be constructed of Level 2, ½ inch dense HMAC ODOT asphalt concrete for the roadway.
- 16. Construction hours are from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. daily.
- 17. Contractors that are not a public utility are required to have a Construction Contractors License from the State of Oregon.
- 18. Contractor is liable for street cut for one year after project is completed.
